English

We are now ending our work on the text 'Me and You.' The children have been writing their own character descriptions of the character Goldilocks. They used lots of expanded noun phrases and adjectives to describe her. We are really impressed with the children's work during this text and look forward to seeing their progress as the year continues.

Maths

In Maths, we have been working hard on multiplication. The children are using a range of methods such as grouping and physical resources to group equally.

Science

In Science, our unit is animal including humans. The children have identifying which animals are vertebrates and invertebrates.

History

Our topic this half term is The Great Fire of London. We have explored how the fire started and why it spread so quickly.

Geography

In Geography, we have explored both human and physical features. We have identified both the human and physical features that are most important to our local area.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children are looking at their topic Celebrating Difference. We have identified differences between them and their partners.

Art

For our Art, we are exploring the artist Antoni Gaudi. The children have explored different materials and patterns he used in his designs.
