Phonics

Children continue to work hard during their phonic lessons. This week children have learnt the sounds v,y,w,x,z. Please over the half term can you ensure children are recapping previously taught sounds to ensure they are remembering them fluently in preparation for beginning to read.

Literacy

As our final writing piece for our Literacy text, Bringing the Rain to Kapiti Plain, children have enjoyed using description words to describe African animals. Children had the opportunity to write sounds in words using their Fred fingers to support.

Maths

Within maths children have been focussing on comparison. Children used language of 'more than' and 'fewer than' to compare sets of objects with their peers. Please continue to support your child with using this language at home.

General

Children have enjoyed learning about Howard Hodgkin and Pablo Picasso in our art lessons.

They have completed their unit on Fundamental skills in PE which focussed on running and stopping, changing direction, hopping and landing.

Children have opportunities to sing and explore musical instruments each week within their Music sessions.
