Phonics

This week phonic sounds are: c,k,u,b,f.

The children have been working so hard, learning a new sound a day. Please help your child remember the newly taught sounds and practise writing them.

<u>Literacy</u>

This week we have come to the end of our literacy text, Where The Wild Things Are. The children have loved this story and have created their own wild things this week. They were able to describe features on their wild thing using different describing words. We will be starting a new text next week.

<u>Maths</u>

Our maths this week has been looking at composition of 3. This is exploring what makes 3. Children learnt the phrase "1 and 1 and 1 makes 3". Children have been creating patterns of 3 and describing them. The children have learnt from practical experiences that a 'whole' is made up of smaller parts and is, therefore, bigger than its parts.

<u>Other</u>

In Art children have been learning all about the artist Howard Hodgkin. They have begun creating their own Howard Hodgkin inspired paintings using sponges to create effect.

In PE children continue to enhance their fundamental skills of running, stopping and changing direction. Children have been enjoying our PSHE lessons with Jigsaw Jenie. Children have opportunities to practise breathing techniques and have been talking about their emotions.
