We have returned back from the Christmas break happy and eager to learn. Reception have had a busy start and have settled quickly back into the routine of the day. As phonics starts promptly at 9 am please ensure the children arrive at school at 8.40 am. Phonics

The children are working hard during phonics and we have covered most of our set 1 sounds. Children now stream into ability groups and are making rapid progress. Please support your children at home and work on forming those letters too. Book bags need to come into school each day. Literacy

We have really enjoyed our Literacy Tree Text, The Magic Paintbrush. The children have been challenged to think of items that the Magic Paintbrush could paint for the poor. They have also used their writing skill to build words and have a go at a short phrase or sentence.

Maths

This week in maths the children look at composition of numbers 5 and 6. We use five frames and familiar rhymes. We look how we can represent numbers using the Hungarian number pattern (Die pattern). We search for the 5-ness of 5.

UTW

The Children have enjoyed RE and we explore clothes from around the world. Stories, discussions and arts and crafts support the children's' learning. We are now hoping to gather items to allow the children to dress up and explore further. PHSE

This term for our_Jigsaw curriculum we start our topic, Healthy Me. The children categorise healthy foods and non-healthy foods and talk about healthy bodies, exercise and positive thoughts. We hope to complete the mile walk each week.
