

English

This half term we are studying the texts, Small and the City by Sydney Smith and Neri and the Lonely Fisherman by Ian Eagleton. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

Groovy Gymnastics – Children will explore a variety of jumps with safe and stable landings. Children will also create and perform a sequence.

Skip to the Beat – children will develop their skipping technique with control and balance.

Computing

Logo – Children will learn the structure of the coding language of Logo and input simple instructions in Logo.

Branching Databases – Children will sort objects using just 'yes' or 'no' questions and complete a branching database using 2Question.

Maths

Length – Children will learn to measure different items using centimetres, metres and kilometres. They will also learn to convert different units of measurement as well as compare different lengths.

Mass – Children look at different units to measure mass, specifically grams and kilograms.

French

Instruments – Learn a range of musical instruments in French.

History

The Shang Dynasty – children will explore when and how the Shang Dynasty began and who Fu Hao is and why we know her. They will study why the Shang Dynasty ended and how they used and created Chinese writing. They will also learn what life was like for people in the Shang Dynasty.
