Messages

- At home, children should have weekly access to Accelerated Reader, Maths.co.uk, Spelling Shed and Times Table Rock Stars. These form part of children's weekly homework tasks, in addition to weekly spellings.
- This year, children will be completing their National Times Tables Assessment in June. Please remember
 to encourage children to practice and learn their times tables at home, particularly the 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 and
 12 times tables. In school, children are receiving 30 minutes of daily practice using 'Sound Check' on
 Times Table Rock Stars. This should also be practiced regularly at home in preparation for the upcoming
 assessment.
- Please note our PE times are now Tuesdays and Thursdays. Children should attend school wearing their PE kits on these days.

Guided Reading/ English

We are currently reading the book 'Stargazing: Explore the Sky in the Day and Night' by Anna Claybourne in Guided Reading. In English, we have started to read 'The Story of Tutankhamun' by Patricia Cleveland-Peck. Daily lessons will be based on these books.

Maths

Children have moved onto 'Workbook 4B, Chapter 8 – Decimals' where they are: writing tenths; writing hundredths; dividing by 10 and 100; making number patterns; comparing and ordering decimals; rounding decimals; and, writing fractions as decimals.

Science – Physics

- Throughout our topic on 'Space', children will answer the following questions: What are solar and lunar eclipses? What is the solar system? How do the planets in the solar system differ? What are stars and star constellations? What is the universe and what is it made from? What do astronomers do?
