Literacy

Our current Literacy text is, The Tiny Seed. Children have enjoyed planting various seeds such as Sunflower, Runner beans and Cress. The children are enjoying ensuring that they are watered and they are waiting patiently for these to grow. We have been writing instructions on how to plant a seed as our focus group this week.

Maths

This week, the children have used practical contexts to sort objects according to different attributes such as colour, size or function. This then led onto children using their sorting skills to sort numbers, exploring even and odd numbers.

In PE children are enhancing their fundamental skills again and this week we had a focus on balancing. The children enjoyed a circus themed lesson, where they could pretend they were different acts in the circus to enhance their balancing skills.
