Our Year 2 Road Safety sessions have now been completed and the children have learnt a lot about staying safe around cars and looking out for dangers. This week we have celebrated British Science Week. The children have enjoyed becoming farmers in our live lesson and thought about the job their brains do as we are learning new things.

English

The children have been looking at the text 'We are Water Protectors.' We are now writing our own persuasive campaigns to encourage others to become water protectors!

Maths

In Maths, we have been looking at temperature. We have looked at a thermometer and how it is used to measure the temperature.

Science

In Science, we are looking at Human Lifestyle. We have been looking at how we change as we grow older and completing a timeline from a baby to an adult.

Geography

Our topic this half term is Our World. We have been comparing the physical and human features of South Africa.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children are looking at their topic Healthy Me. We have thought about medicine safety and discussed the rules for when we are using medicines.

Art

For Art this half term, we are looking at the artist L. S. Lowry. The children are looking at creating different shades using a range of different pencils.

RE

In RE, the children are learning about New Beginnings. We are exploring what happened after Palm Sunday.

Music

In Music, we are looking at the Friendship song. We are learning the pulse and rhythm of the music.

We have begun our GymFit unit. The children have been completing a circuit of gym activities including stretches, balances and forward rolls. We have been thinking about our start and end positions. Each week we will challenge ourselves further to improve our movements.
