English

We have started our new book called 'Leo and the Octopus.' The children are focusing on using the conjunctions 'when' and 'because' as well as using the suffix 's' and 'es' at the end of a word.

Maths

In Maths, we have started our new topic, solving word problems. We have been looking at number problems and putting them into a story to create a word problem.

Science

In Science, our unit this half term is Sound. We have begun by learning all about the 5 senses and will focus on how we hear sounds. The children have learnt a multiple words in sign language too!

History

Our History topic for this term is The Great Fire of London. The children have started by looking at fire safety and how we can keep ourselves safe around fire. We have now found out all about how the fire started and how it spread.

PSHE

In PSHE, we are enjoying the Jigsaw unit Healthy Me. The children will be exploring how we can make healthy choices.

DT

In DT we will be focusing on 'freestanding structures.' We have searched around the school grounds for freestanding structures and we will be making our own playground out of cardboard!

Music

In Music, we will be completing the unit, round and round. We have been looking at finding the pulse to the music and we will be performing our own song.

PE

The children will take part in throwing and catching and gym fit circuits. We have already seen such a huge improvement in the children's balance and also their throwing and catching skills.
