English

This half term we are studying the texts, Yeti and the Bird by Nadia Shireen and Pig the Pug Aaron Blabey. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

<u>Plants – children</u> will learn how to plant a bean and what types of plants grow in the wild. They will learn the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees and learn the main parts of trees and plants. They will explore changes in a tomato plant and in their bean plant.

R.E

Our Planet – children will think about what our world is like and how our world began. They will then explore stories from The Bible which explains this.

Phonics

Children have 20 minutes of phonics everyday followed by a 20 minute guided reading session where they apply their new phonetic knowledge directly to a Read, Write, Inc. text.

PSHE

Relationships – Children will explore belonging to a family and making a good friend. Children will think about people who help them and the qualities of a good person.

Music

<u>Your imagination</u> – children will explore a pop song about using their imagination. Children will listen and appraise and learn to sing this song.

<u>P.E</u>

Story Time Dance - children will learn to change direction during travelling moves and how to link travelling moves that change direction and level.

<u>Mighty Movers</u> – children will explore running at a variety of speeds and in a variety of styles.

Computing

<u>Coding</u>_-children will understand what instructions are and predict what might happen when they are followed. They will use code to make a computer program and understand what object and actions are.

Maths

Children will recap on previous learning around multiplication and apply these skills to problem solving scenarios. They will then understand how to divide even numbers into equal groups using concrete materials and determine how many groups will be created. Children will learn how to split an object into two equal parts and identify shapes that have been split.

Geography

Coasts and Seas – South Africa – children will learn what makes a seaside location and explore seaside locations close to where they live. They will study what coastal locations and seas surround the UK and learn about the human and physical features. They will then learn about how coasts change over time.
