# **English**

This half term we are studying the texts, Jim and the Beanstalk by Raymond Briggs and Toys in Space by Mini Grey. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

#### Science

<u>Plants – children will learn how to plant a</u> bean and what types of plants grow in the wild. They will learn the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees and learn the main parts of trees and plants. They will explore changes in a tomato plant and in their bean plant.

## R.E

Special Places – children will discuss what makes a place special and how they feel in their special place.

They will then think about where a special place is to a Christian on earth and why Christians go to church.

## **Phonics**

Children have 20 minutes of phonics everyday followed by a 20 minute guided reading session where they apply their new phonetic knowledge directly to a Read, Write, Inc. text.

#### **PSHE**

Relationships – children will explore different types of family and physical contact boundaries. They will study friendship, conflict, secrets, trust and appreciation.

### Music

**Zoo time** – children will explore a reggae song. Children will listen and appraise and learn to sing this song.
