

English

This half term we are studying the texts, Goldilocks & the Three Bears Lauren Child You & Me Anthony Browne Goldilocks & Just the One Bear. Through these texts, we will +be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

Habitats – Children will learn that all animals need energy to survive. They will explore how plants make their own food using the sun and that a food chain describes the order in which organisms depend on each other for food and that this creates a flow of energy between living things. They will also study micro-organisms.

R.E

Places of Worship - Children will learn about places of worship and why they are so important to different faiths.

Phonics

Children have 20 minutes of phonics everyday followed by a 20 minute guided reading session where they apply their new phonetic knowledge directly to a Read, Write, Inc. text.

PSHE

Changing Me – children will study life cycles in nature and explore growing from young to old. They will look at differences between male and female using correct terminology.

Music

RRR- This unit focusses on revisiting songs studied throughout the year.
