English

<u>P.E</u>

Active Athletics - Children will improve core strength and agility and understand why they are important.

Fitness Frenzy - Children will demonstrate the correct technique for activities and develop their agility and co-ordination.

Computing

<u>Graphing – children will learn to enter data into a graph and answer questions. They will then solve an investigation and present the results in a graphic form.</u>

Maths

Children will learn what makes an angle and identify angles in an object. They will find right, acute and obtuse angles in shapes. They will also identify and create perpendicular and parallel lines as well as describing 2D and 3D shapes, including nets. Finally, children will determine the perimeter of basic shapes often using 1cm paper before using multiplication and division to find the perimeter of any shape.

Geography
