

English

This half term we are studying the text *The Baker by the Sea* by Paula White and *Pride: The Story of Harvey Milk and the Rainbow Flag* by Rob Sanders. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

Anatomy – children will study human organs and why we have them. They will explore the major bones in the body and how human anatomy compares to other animals. In addition they will study teeth and how they differ and how humans digest food.

Applying all reading skills to a variety of contexts, including fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

PSHE

Changing Me – children will learn about how a baby grows and will understand a baby's needs. They will think about inside and outside body changes and explore stereotypes, preparing for transition.

Singing Lessons – children will have singing lessons with Mrs Walton.

Swimming – sessions at local leisure centre

Nimble Nets – children will learn a variety of shots in a game situation and explore when different shots should be played

Computing

Effective Search – children will locate information on the search results page and search effectively to find out information.

Animation – children will decide what makes a good, animated film or cartoon and discuss favourite animations.

Maths

Children will identify types of angles and classify triangles and quadrilaterals. They will draw lines of symmetry as well as drawing symmetrical figures. They will also describe position, plot coordinates and describe movement. Finally children will learn and write roman numerals to 100.

French

Ancient Britain – children will learn a range of words linked to Ancient Britain in French.

History
