Reading.

Applying all reading skills to a range of contexts including, fiction, non - fiction, poetry and media.

Science

Energy – children will study energy stores and energy transformation. They will study what energy efficiency is and how it can be calculated and what power is and how it can apply to electrical appliances. They will also study how we relate speed, distance and time.

R.E

Easter- Lent/Promises – children will explore what the event of Lent is and the idea of promises.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals – children will understand that they will need money to help them achieve some of their dreams. They will explore a range of jobs carried out by people and explore how much people earn in different jobs.

Music

P.E

Striking and Fielding – children will throw and catch under pressure and know how to react quickly. They will also demonstrate good agility and balance in order to throw accurately.

Gym Fit Circuits – children will develop a personal programme that is suitable for each child, using the knowledge and understanding they have learned from previous fitness sessions.

Computing

3D modelling – children will explore the effect of moving points when designing before designing a 3D model to fit certain criteria.

Maths

Children will write decimal numbers and read write, order and compare decimals. They will add and subtract amounts in pound and pence and round decimals to the nearest whole number. Children will then compare quantities and convert values of an amount in percentages.

History

Medieval Monarchs – children will explore the succession crisis in 1066 and study who was responsible for Thomas Becket's death. They will decide which king was worse, John or Richard before exploring what makes a great monarch.

French

What is the date? – Children will learn how to ask and answer the date in French.

Art and Design

Leonardo Da Vinci – children will research this artist, experiment with some of his famous styles before designing and creating their own unique piece.
