

English

This half term we are studying the text, The Three Little Pigs and The Unforgotten Coat by Frank Cottrell- Boyce. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose. Children will also draft, edit and publish their writing for display.

Science

Diet and Lifestyle – children will learn how people with different lifestyles need different diets. They will study the effects different diets have on the environment and what happens to the body during exercise. They will explore medicinal drugs, nicotine and alcohol and how scientific knowledge improved human health over time.

R.E

Precious – children will learn the importance of the Beatitudes for Christians and explore the importance of symbols for believers. They will then explore the significance of religious items.

Reading

Applying all reading skills to a variety of contexts, including fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

PSHE

Changing Me – children will explore self and body image and the influence of online and media. They will explore puberty for both girls and boys and begin to learn about conception (including IVF). They will learn about coping with changing and preparing for this transition.

P.E

Cool Core (Pilates) – children will devise a sequence of yoga/Pilates moves with fluency and accuracy

Gym Sequences – children will use counterbalances and incorporate them into a sequence of movements and perform movements in canon and in unison

Computing

Spreadsheets – children will use spreadsheet to investigate the probability of the results of throwing many dice and to calculate the discount and final prices in a sale.

Maths

Children will convert units of length, including centimetres and metres. They will solve problems by converting units of length. They will also convert units of mass, including grams into kilograms and solve problems. Children will find the perimeter of different shapes in square meters.

French

At the Tea Room – children will learn about items and actions at the tea room.

Geography

Trade and Economics – children will learn what trade is and how it affects the economy. They will study UK trade and globalisation and how this impacts the world. They will then study what a 'global chain' is and how trade has changed over time.

Art and Design

Faith Ringgold – children will study this artist before experimenting with colour. They will then design, make and evaluate their own inspired piece.
