

English

This half term we are studying the texts, *Alte Zachan: Old Things* by Ziggy Hanaor and *The Promise* by Nicola Davies. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

Cells – children will study the difference between living and non-living things and the main organ systems of the body. They will learn what organ systems, organs, tissues and cells and what animal and plant cells are. They will also study specialised cells.

Precious/Artefacts & Symbols – children will explore different values and the importance of worth and they will understand the importance of feeling precious to God for the believer.

Reading

Applying all reading skills to a variety of contexts, including fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals – children will reflect on their learning strengths and set challenging but realistic goals for themselves. They will work out the learning steps they need to reach their goal and understand how to motivate themselves to work on these.

Music

Happy children will listen and appraise and learn to sing the pop song Happy.

Year 6 Curriculum Map Summer 1

P.E

Boot Camp – children will complete a range of circuit-based activities and understand the reason for doing them

Nimble Nets – children will learn to play a tennis game using an overhead serve and the correct selections of shots. They will understand and use doubles scoring in a tennis game.

Computing

Spreadsheets – children will use spreadsheet to investigate the probability of the results of throwing many dice and to calculate the discount and final prices in a sale.

Maths

Children will calculate the average (mean) of sets of values and read and interpret pie charts and line graphs. They will add and subtract negative numbers using a number line and find the volume of cubes and cuboids using concrete materials. They will also use estimation and solve word problems.

French

Recap/Revision – children will recap on the basics and more complex language knowledge and skills.

Geography

Trade and Economics – children will learn what trade is and how it affects the economy. They will study UK trade and globalisation and how this impacts the world. They will then study what a 'global chain' is and how trade has changed over time.

Design Technology

Food Celebrating Culture and seasonality

Children will explore and research a range of seasonal food, before planning and making their own dish.
