English

• We are now starting our new unit of work based on the book Black Dog by Levi Pinfold. The Children will learn how to use a range of language techniques to describe characters and setting before writing their own version of the story.

<u>Maths</u>

• We have now completed our addition and subtraction unit of maths and have now started looking at multiplication. We are learning how to quickly and efficiently re-call our multiplication facts up to 12 x 12 using a variety of approaches such as arrays and repeated addition. On Wednesday we will also be taking part in a TT Rockstars National Battle so please continue to practice at home

<u>Science</u>

• In Science, we have now moved onto our new unit- Raw and Synthetic materials. The children will learn about a variety of natural and man-made materials as well as conducting a range of scientific investigations.

• We have now moved onto our new geography topic- The North West. The children will explore the different regions of the North West, as well as study some of the human and physical geographical features of these areas.
