Guided Reading

In **The Man Who Walked Between the Towers** by Mordicai Gerstein, children have: written a formal interview transcript; written quotations in a journalistic style; used modal verbs to write a persuasive speech; and, planned a biography.

Maths

Our new topic is **Measurements**, where children are: converting centimetres and millimetres; converting metres and centimetres; converting kilometres and metres; converting kilograms and grams; converting litres and millilitres; converting imperial and metric units of measurement; reading the temperature; solving word problems of time; and, solving word problems of length, mass and volume.
