It has been a great couple of weeks back, and the classroom has been full of energy, smiles, and fantastic learning. The children have settled back into routines so well and have been busy exploring new activities, sharing ideas, and supporting one another. English

In English, we have begun our new class text *The Pied Piper of Hamelin* by Michael Morpurgo. The children have been exploring the key features of traditional tales and myths. They enjoyed imagining what it would be like if thousands of rats took over a town and used this idea to write informative paragraphs full of interesting rat facts.

Maths

Over the last couple of weeks, we have finished our learning on measuring length and mass. The children have been converting between millimetres, centimetres and metres, as well as kilograms and grams, and applying these skills to solve a range of problems.

Science

In Science, we have continued our work on forces, focusing on non-contact forces. We explored gravity and learned how the Earth acts like a giant magnet.

Art

In Art, we have been learning about primary colours and how to mix them to create secondary colours. The children painted concentric circles to create mandala-style artwork and designed detailed, repeating patterns with great care and creativity.
