English

We are currently reading Cloud Tea Monkeys. The children are enjoying the story and are developing their understanding of the characters and setting. As part of our learning, we are writing a report about tea, linking to the themes in the text. This is helping the children to organise information clearly and use more formal writing styles.

Maths

We have recently completed our work on bar graphs and pictograms, where the children have been collecting, interpreting and presenting data. We are now moving on to fractions, where we will be exploring how to recognise, compare and work with fractions in a range of contexts. The children will also continue to develop their problem-solving and reasoning skills.

Science

This half-term our focus is light. The children will be exploring how light travels, how we see objects, and how shadows are formed. They will be carrying out practical investigations to help deepen their understanding and develop their scientific enquiry skills.

P.E

In P.E. this term, we are focusing on athletics and tennis. The children will be developing their running, jumping and throwing techniques in athletics, alongside learning and improving key racket skills in tennis such as control, accuracy and coordination.
