We have had a fantastic start to our Spring 2 term. The children have had a visit from the road safety team this week to teach us all about how to be safe when we are near roads and crossing them. We are continuing to push reading progress this half term and we are asking for parents to spend 10 minutes a night reading with their child if this is possible.

Next Thursday is World Book Day. A message has been sent out to parents to inform that all children are welcome to come into school wearing their pyjamas and bring along their favourite book to share with their peers on the day.

English

We have started our new text 'Owl and the Pussycat'. The children have explored different vocabulary and their meanings.

Maths

In Maths, we have started our topic of Pictograms. The children have been learning how to read, interpret, analyse and construct their own picture graphs with confidence.

Science

In Science, our unit this half term is Plants. The children have been exploring how seeds need water to germinate. As a class we have planted two seeds in different pots. We are going to water one seed and not water the other seed to see what happens.

History

In History this half term, the children will be completing local area studies. They will be looking into the history of the area of Whiston.

Geography

In Geography, we are exploring the differences between England and Kenya. We have been exploring Kenya's capital city of Nairobi and the similarities and difference with both Nairobi to London.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children are starting our new topic of Healthy me. The children will explore different ways to keep both our mind and body healthy.

ART

For our Art this half term, we are beginning our topic of printing. The children will have been using different fruits and vegetables such as potatoes to create positive and negative patterns using their object and ink.

RE

In RE, the children have been learning about Palm Sunday and understanding the importance of Palm Leaves.

PE

This half term we are completing Ball Skills and Ball games. The children have been using varied size balls and aiming at different targets.
