English

In English, we have been exploring the story of Winter's Child and Tom, a boy who wishes for eternal Winter. The children have discussed what the conversations would be between the boys and have begun to explore noun phrases to describe. The children have enjoyed the themes of this story and I look forward to seeing their imagination come to life through their stories.

Guided Reading

In our guided reading sessions, we have finished exploring 'Poems of the Green and Blue Planet' where the children have explored different styles of poem and different themes and have now moved onto How a Lighthouse Works. The children have enjoyed learning more about lighthouses and the different famous monuments that are still active today!

Maths

We have completed Chapter 3 and are now moving on to further multiplication and division. The children have been mastering the commutative law and exploring different problem-solving strategies. Regular practice at home on TT Rockstars will help solidify these skills. Please encourage the children to practice on TT rockstars, as it will support them in current and future learning.

<u>Science</u>

In science, we have been looking at states of matter and what makes a solid, liquid and gas. The children have considered how volume can change or be perceived as different, depending on the item. We have started to explore melting and the children predicted what would happen if we added heat to butter and how it would change from a solid to a liquid. It has been great to see how their imagination works and how they apply their prior knowledge to new learning.
