English

We have continued with our work on the text 'Me and You.' The children have been exploring different sentence types such as commands, exclamations, questions and statements. Maths

In Maths, we have started our topic of division. The children have been using practical resources to share them into equal groups.

Science

In Science, our unit is animal including humans. The children have identifying which animals are vertebrates and invertebrates and the life cycle of these animals.

History

Our topic this half term is The Great Fire of London. We have explored how the fire started and why it spread so quickly.

Geography

In Geography, we have been exploring the capital city of London. We have been identifying numerous landmarks.
