CURRICULUM

Guided Reading/ English

Next week in Guided Reading, children will begin to read the book Letters from the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll. In English, we have been reading Children of the Benin Kingdom by Dinah Orji where they have: asked a range of questions; written a letter in future tense; made inferences based on evidence from the text; and, used conjunctions to show contrasting thoughts and feelings.

Science

Children have been completing their topic on Forces, answering the following questions: When is friction helpful and when is it not?; What's the effect of air resistance?; What's the effect of water resistance?; Who was Galileo Galilei?; How do levers help us?; and, How do pulleys and gears help us? Our next topic is named Earth in Space.

Geography/ History

In 4 and 6-Figure Grid References children are: using latitude and longitude; using four and six-figure grid references; and, precisely describing locations, landmarks and places. In History, children are leaning about: where Maya lived; significant Maya events, Maya city states and what happened to these; what the Maya invented; how Maya compare and contrast to the Anglo-Saxons.

Art/Design

We have started to create some beautiful sculptures using natural materials inspired by artist Anthony Goldsworthy.
