This week in Nursery we have enjoyed sequencing the story "Monkey and Me". Children enjoyed using props and visual images to repeat phrases to sequence the story and make a class washing line of events.

To support our early phonics, we considered animal sounds and played environmental sound guessing games.

We have enjoyed lots of outdoor learning in our bug garden and grassed areas. Children planted hyacinth bulbs and began a photo diary to record growth and change over time. As always we have enjoyed our music sessions and learnt some action songs and rhymes.

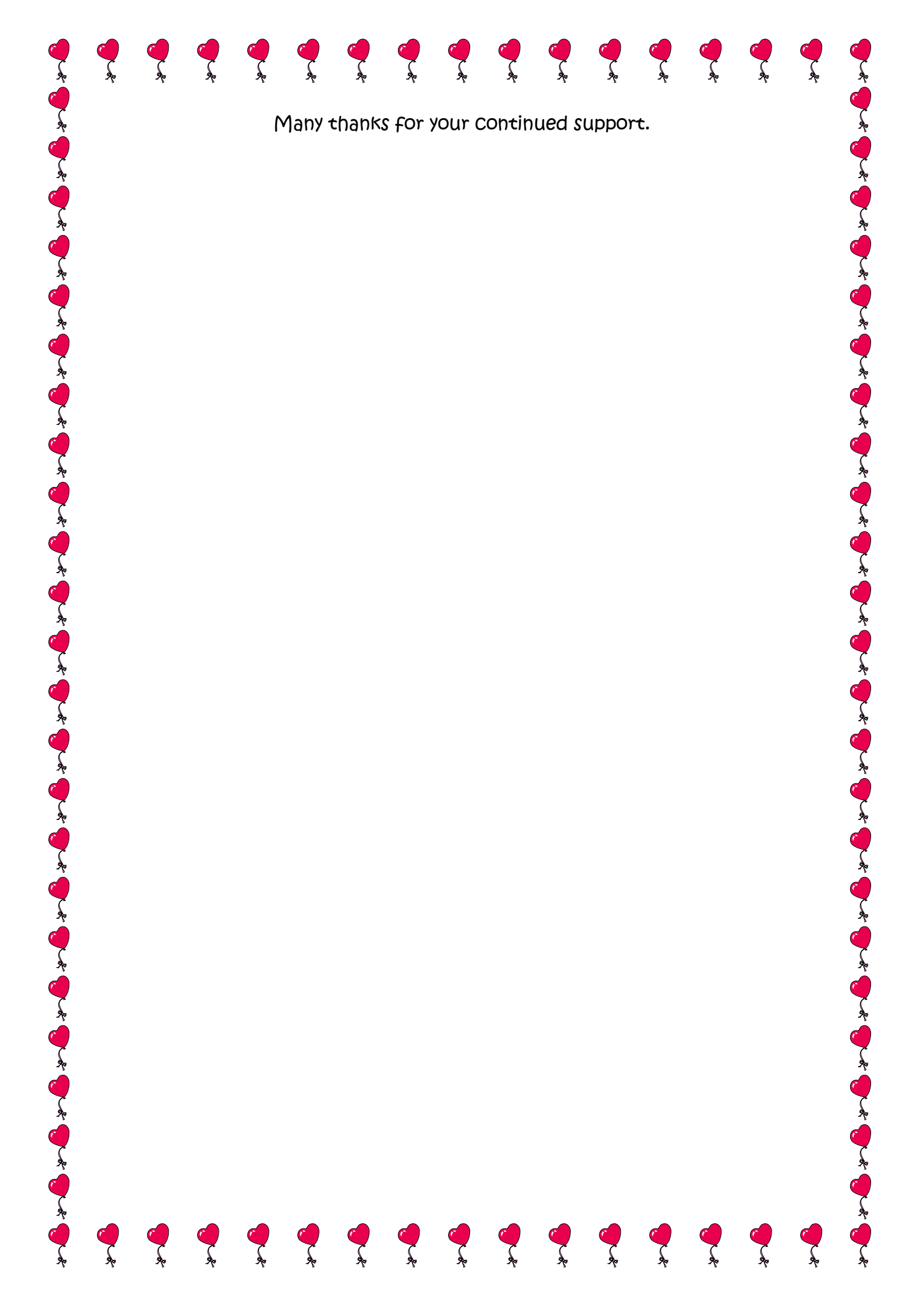
Please see the enclosed home activity sheet and complete the suggested 'what can you hear?' activity to help support your child's listening skills and awareness of environmental sounds.
