Activity 1:

<u>Step I-</u> On a sunny day, look outside for areas with strong shadow patterns, on the ground or even against buildings. All kinds of things make interesting shadows.... fences, railings, chairs, trees and all kinds of plants.

<u>Step 2-</u> Lay down a piece of paper over the shadow.

<u>Step 3-</u> Then, trace the shadow with a pencil. (You'll need to work *quickly*, as shadows change with the movement of the sun!)

Your tracing will show both positive and negative shapes. (The shadow is the positive shape and the space around it is the negative shape.)
