English

- This week, the children have been writing a letter to Rabbit from the book 'I want my hat back'. They are also becoming experts at using our 'high five your sentence'. This helps them to write using the non-negotiable skills required for writing a sentence.

Maths

- In maths, the children have been focusing on numbers to ten, reading and writing the digits as numerals and words. They are moving on to exploring new vocabulary to compare numbers of objects.

Science

- This half-term, we will be looking at sound. We started off our unit by exploring the five senses. They listened to what they could hear in our environment and explored taste, touch, sight and smell in some exciting ways.

Geography

- This week, the children have been finding out about where their school is located and exploring the differences between a city, a town and a village. We then took a look at google earth to see what our school looked like and to define a village.

PSHE

- In PSHE, we have been learning about behaviour expectations and what to do in challenging situations. We have discussed what appropriate rewards are and what we are rewarded for in school.

Computing

- In computing, we will be learning about 'Online Safety'. The children have learned how to log on to Purple Mash and how to stay safe online while using a device.

Art

- This week the children have been learning about the artist Lowry. They have explored his artwork and made some observational drawings of his matchstick figures.

RE

- This half-term, we will be learning about 'Hinduism', we have learnt about the greeting 'Namaste' and how Hindus pray daily using a shrine in their homes.

French

- We have started to learn French, we are learning some key vocabulary and using to sing nursery rhymes. The children have learnt how to say 'etoile', 'petite' and 'diamant' and are learning to sing Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star in French.
