Welcome back

The staff in Pangolin Class would like to give a warm welcome to all our new pupils, parents, and carers this academic year. The children have had a fantastic first week back and are showing a great attitude towards their learning. We are looking forward to a brilliant year together!

English

- Our new sequence of learning is based on the book 'I want my hat back' by Jon Klassen. The children have enjoyed the beginning of the story and making predictions on who has taken the bear's hat. We have role played what will happen next in the story and the children have been practising writing basic sentences using their punctuation and ambitious vocabulary.

Maths

- In maths, the year 2 children have started looking at place value and what each digit represents in a 2 digit number. We have been using partitioning and tens and ones grids to show the value of these numbers.
- Our year 1 children have been focusing on numbers to ten, representing items in a tens frame and showing how to count items accurately.

Science

- This half-term, we will be looking at materials and their properties. We are explore different objects and to learn to identify what they are made from.

Geography

- This half-term, we will be studying our school in our local area. The children will be looking at maps and will learn to recognise map symbols.

PSHE

- In PSHE, we are learning about 'New Beginnings'. We have talked about our new class so far and worries we might have for the year ahead. Together we have started to come up with some rights that everyone in our classroom is entitled to. The children suggested ideas such as always listening to one another and offering a helping hand if someone needs it.
