



Dear Parents,

We have prepared the site for our wider reopening on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June and you will see a number of measures in place to welcome the children back. The information below will apply From Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020.

In order to maintain social distancing measures, we are using one way and queueing systems on the school ground that we do ask you to respect and adhere to. Dropping children off and picking them up may take longer than usual but this is necessary to ensure we are as 'COVID SECURE' as possible.

I am sure you will appreciate the logistical challenge of organising PODS for children and whilst we have tried to consider friendships and class groups, we cannot guarantee that your child will be with all of their friends or with their normal teacher. This has been unavoidable based on our pupil capacity in PODS and staffing availability.

I would also like to remind you that we will be following government guidance in all our procedures and the most important rule for us all to follow is that nobody should enter the school site if they have symptoms of COVID 19. To support us with this, Wade Deacon Trust have developed 'safety rules' (see letter on school website) and this includes all children having their temperature taken at the school entrance they use. Please expect staff to ask questions about health to you as you drop children each day.

On your child's first day, they will receive an updated COVID 19 Home School Agreement which is available on the school website and would be useful to share with them before Monday.

Please use the painted floor markings as a guide for social distancing and queueing.

To reduce the risk of cross contamination of COVID-19, the following plans are in place:

- Children will work in groups of similar age children in PODS, not mixing with any other groups of children at any point during the day
- A limited number of adults will remain with your child's bubble and will not mix with other bubbles
- These groups will have separate equipment and use play areas at different times
- All children will have packed lunches in their classrooms. Please note that the kitchen will not be serving hot food
- Desks in classrooms will be spaced out and non-contact activities will be completed
- Children will be provided with all the necessary equipment and should only bring their packed lunch and drink.
- Children can wear their own clothes and these should be fresh clothes each day. We suggest wearing weather appropriate clothing and sportswear on PE days (this will be shared next week)
- Children should not bring bags to school.
- There will be no breakfast or after school club provision.
- We will not be sending any books or work home and children should not bring anything in from home.

We do look forward to welcoming the children back to school next week.
