

## English

This half term we are studying the texts, *I want my Hat Back* by Jon Klassen, *The Magic Bed* by John Burningham and *Dinosaurs and All That Rubbish* by Michael Foreman. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

## Science

Changing Materials - children will learn that natural materials are materials that are 'naturally' found and that synthetic materials are made by humans. They will explore the sources of both natural and synthetic materials and investigate the properties of materials.

## R.E

Hinduism - Children will explore the Hindu faith and compare and contrast their beliefs to others.

## Phonics

Children have 20 minutes of phonics everyday followed by a 20 minute guided reading session where they apply their new phonetic knowledge directly to a Read, Write, Inc. text.

## PSHE

Being Me in My World - children will explore their hopes and fears for the year and discuss their rights and responsibilities. Children will also contribute to their class charter.

## Music

Hey You! - Children will march in time with the beat, clap a rhythm and rap to the song *Hey You!*

## P.E

Brilliant Ball Skills - children will master basic sending and receiving techniques and develop balance, agility and co-ordination.

Gymfit Circuits - children will identify techniques to improve balance and perform using simple movement patterns.

## Computing

Online Safety - children will learn to log on safely, how to find saved work and how to find teacher comments.

## Maths

Children will learn to count numbers up to 100 using concrete objects, counting up by ones and tens. They will understand that each number has its own value and compare numbers using place value. Children will add one-digit numbers to two-digit numbers without regrouping and add 1 digit to 2 digit resulting in renaming the ones. Children will also learn to add three 1-digit numbers.

## Geography

Our School and the Local Area - children will learn about their local area and the key points of interest within close proximity to school. They will also learn directional language and learn map skills when reciting their route to school.

## Art and Design

L.S Lowry - children will research the British male artist L. S. Lowry. They will explore colour and practise the skill of drawing in their sketch books before imitating the work of Lowry.
