## P.E

Brilliant Ball Skills - Children will be aware of others when playing games and choose the correct skills to meet a challenge. They will learn to dribble a ball with greater control.

Gymfit Circuits - identify techniques to improve balance and master basic movements, agility and coordination.

## Computing

Online Safety - children will gain a greater understanding of the impact that sharing digital content can have.

## Maths

Children will create and identify numbers to 10 000 000 and write in numerals and words numbers to 10 000 000. They will construct and record numbers to 10 000 000 and recognise the value of digits to 10 000 000. Children will use multiple operations and create expressions from a picture and use the order of operations to solve expressions. They will multiply 3- and 4-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers with regrouping and renaming.

## Geography

The Polar Regions - children will learn all about The Polar Regions located in the Arctic and Antarctic. They will learn about the countries which inhabit the Polar Regions and the physical features. They will also learn about Global Warming and the affect that this is having on our planet.

## Art and Design
