

English

PSHE

Celebrating Difference – children will study different perceptions of normality and understand disability. They will also understand bullying, inclusion and exclusion.

Music

Living on a Prayer – children will learn to listen and appraise, comment on pitch, rhythm and rhyme and sing and play instruments.

P.E

Tri-Golf – children will learn the skills of Tri- Golf.

Dance – children will identify and practise the patterns and actions in a street dance style.

Computing

Databases – children will learn how to search for information in a database and contribute to a class database before creating a database around a chosen topic.

Game Creator – children will learn how to plan, create and evaluate a game.

Maths

Children will learn to read and write decimals to thousandths and to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. They will learn to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. Children will then convert common measurements into metres, centimetres and millimetres using knowledge of decimals and fractions to help convert units.

History

Volcanoes and Earthquakes – children will learn how the Earth causes natural disasters and how the Earth's structure impacts the formation of plate tectonics. They will explore the different plate boundaries and learn what causes an earthquake. They will also learn what makes a volcano erupt.

French

Weather – children will learn words and phrases in French, linked to weather.

Textiles – children will learn about different fabrics and learn how to join them together. They will then design, make and evaluate a mobile phone case.
