CURRICULUM

Guided Reading/ English – Children have enjoyed reading **Poems from World War 2** in Guided Reading. Children are now reading **Freedom Bird** in English.

Maths – In **Fractions**, children are: dividing to make fractions; writing improper fractions and mixed numbers; finding equivalent fractions; comparing and ordering fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers; making number pairs; adding and subtraction fractions; multiplying whole numbers by proper fractions; multiplying proper fractions and whole numbers; and, multiplying mixed numbers and whole numbers.
