## Understanding the World

Children will be encouraged to:

- Become "shiny detectives" exploring shiny objects in a shiny treasure hunt
- Explore a range of shiny objects, torches & mirrors. Ask questions to prompt thinking.
- Become a light detective!
- Make tarnished copper coin shiny with vinegar and salt mixture.
- Sort shiny/non-shiny objects
- Learn about road safety (high vis jackets and reflective road signs
- Explore dark dens and torches
- Learn about Chinese New Year celebrations

## MATHEMATICS

Children will be encouraged to:

- Explore ordinal aspect of number.
- Develop understanding that numbers are made up of other numbers.
- Consider how we represent numbers.
- Develop visualisation, explore and investigate number
- Explore the properties of foil. Wrap to create shiny shapes
- Measure quantities to bake star shaped biscuits
- Count and sort shiny glitter glass jewels, baubles, stars
- Create a shiny number line
- Explore Toys and numbered presents- shape and size

## Physical Development

Children will be encouraged to:

- Create a shiny washing line
- Climb confidently on play equipment and show awareness of space, speed and direction
- Use one handed tools and equipment
- Use easy grip tweezers with shiny sequins and gems
- Develop small apparatus skills

## Literacy, communication and Language

Children will be encouraged to:

- Have favourite songs, rhymes, jingles
- Show awareness of writing- Receive a letter from Twinkle the little star.
- Use glitter pens, highlighters, crayons, glitter paint, shave foam and shiny objects to make marks
- Make a shiny browser box to fill with touchy feely books. Talk about and develop vocabulary to describe
- Write potions, lists and spells for Wizard Workshop
- RWI Rhythm and rhyme/oral blending
- Create a shiny reading area/den for range of story including "favourite 5" and "author baskets".**
