Dear Parents/Carers,

RE:WRAP AROUND PROVISION

Our breakfast and afterschool clubs have always been run as a 'not for profit' service that we feel is vital to some families within our community and we will continue to strive to offer this service for all who require this either for early morning or after school childcare provision.

Unfortunately, since September the provision has been running at a loss and up to the end of November, a loss of £1980 was recorded- over £600 per month.

We understand that the need for the service may have reduced due to current circumstances, however we as a school cannot continue to cover losses from the school budget in this way.

The Local Governing Body has considered a number of options moving forward and in the first instance a decision has been made to increase the cost of each session. This will be the first increase in costs for over five years and is a necessity to try to protect the future of the provision and school budgets.

From January, the prices below have been agreed:

Session	cost
Breakfast (7:45 am drop off)	£5 per session
After School (up until 4.30pm)	£5 per session
After school (up until 5.30pm)	£7 per session

The Governors will monitor the provision over the next two months and will then reconsider if any further measures may need to be taken.

If you have any questions regarding this decision, please raise them with the Breakfast/After School Club staff in the first instance.
