## Reminders...

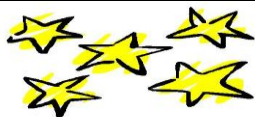
\*. Please check if your child has any missing uniform as we have a number of jumpers and cardigans in Nursery with no names in.
