English

We now start a three-week planning sequence for 'I Want My Hat Back' by Jon Klassen. After experiencing an engaging starting point of looking at and talking about and making predictions about a range of hats, the children read the book. Through role-play, they explore a characters' feelings. They create a short dialogue between the two main characters. Through modelled and shared writing and peer and self- editing, the children write their sequel, 'I Want My Friend Back'.

Maths

Year 1 have now finished their work on addition and subtraction. Now they will gain an understanding of positional language, as well as directional language for left and right. At home utilise Objects for ordering (toys/characters), positional/word number cards – 1st to 10th (one large set between 10), family photographs or pictures with a number of people in them (one between two) and word cards for 'left' and 'right'

Year 2 are continuing to investigate multiplication of 2, 5 and 10. Pupils will also have the opportunity to understand what multiplication means and what it looks like. Patterns in multiplication and commutative law are also covered in this chapter.

I know that their engagement with Times Tables Rockstar is fully supporting them in their class work. Try this at home (see additional sheet)
