




Home learning activities- weekly plan

Activities : Phonics, Literacy, Maths, Physical Development, Understanding of the World, Expressive Arts and Design		
Phonics/ Literacy		<p><u>Phonics</u> - Please watch our Read Write Inc set 1 speed sounds at 9.30am each day on: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCIg9GdxtQ</p> <p>The sounds covered this week are <u>ehurj</u> and there are lots of activities to support this learning on the “Reading and Writing” section of MiniMash.</p> <p><u>Book of the Week/Writing</u>. Watch “The 3 little pigs” https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CtP83CWOMwuc and practise “star” words, <u>straw, sticks, bricks, strong, weak</u>.</p> <p>Get a “talking teddy” and watch this lesson together: https://www.thenationalacademy/reception/english/the-three-little-pigs-reception-wk1-2/ then follow the “Nursery” instructions to draw and label your own picture of your favourite part of the story.</p>
Maths		<p><u>Number 5</u> - Carefully count the fingers on one hand. Draw round your hand - or even do a rainbow handprint with paints - on a piece of paper. Can you find a way to record the number by each finger? You could draw the right number of spots or try writing the number.</p> <p><u>Rhyme time!</u> - Enjoy this “5” number rhyme.
