




Home learning activities- weekly plan

Activities : Phonics, Literacy, Maths, Physical Development, Understanding of the World, Expressive Arts and Design		
Phonics/ Literacy 	<p>Phonics - Please watch our Read Write Inc set 1 speed sounds at 9.30am each day on: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCIq9GdxdQ</p> <p>The sounds covered this week are <u>v</u>, <u>y</u>, <u>w</u>, <u>z</u> and there are lots of activities to support this learning on the "Reading and Writing" section of MiniMash.</p> <p>Book of the Week/Writing. Watch "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=75NqK-SmlYY</p> <p>Can you draw each stage of the caterpillar life cycle- Egg/Caterpillar/ Cocoon/Butterfly. Use the pictures to retell the story.</p>	
Maths 	<p>Measuring - If your beanstalk has grown really tall have you re-potted it into a bigger pot? Can you measure how tall it is? Use lots of different objects to measure with eg, blocks, lego pieces, books. Play Minimash game "Which is the tallest?"</p> <p>Rhyme time! - Enjoy this "5" number rhyme. "Five Little Speckled Frogs". https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-five-little-speckled-frogs/zjzbnrd Can you jump like a frog? Count how many frogs are left when one is taken away.</p>	
EYFS Areas of Learning 	<p>Physical Development - Can you find some material (old bed sheets, table cloth, towels) Can you put the material over your shoulders and make up your own beautiful butterfly dance and movements. Think about speed, direction, body shapes.</p> <p>Understanding the World/Expressive Arts and Design - Can you see any butterflies in the garden? What colour are they? Which is your favourite? On our Minimash "butterfly" pin, can you design/paint your own butterfly?</p> <p>LET'S BAKE! Try some baking- make your own butterfly cakes using 2 eggs, 110g caster sugar, 110g self raising flour, 110g butter. For the icing use 220g icing sugar, 110g butter. Please tweet us a picture of your cakes! Enjoy!</p>
